The yearly book catalogue has reached number 25!

Since the first catalogue of philatelic literature published in 1989, the number of volumes available to collectors and readers has been constantly increasing.

In the present edition, in the general catalogue there are **627 titles**. Among them **60 new books** and the new editions of catalogues, Italian and foreign works about philately and postal history, postage stamps and collecting, history and other subjects connected to the main theme.

The full catalogue is regularly updated in the internet site.

In the section "novità Vaccari"

5 new publications of the "Made in Vaccari", the books published by Vaccari s.r.l. Among classical works, a volume (in Italian, German and English) about the Lombardy-Venetia Kingdom collection of Emil Capellaro by Paolo Vaccari, a real "gem" as it shows, in colour, one of the most important collections in the world. Among catalogues, the biennial Vaccari 2008-2009 specialised in postage stamps and postal history, at its XIII edition: catalogue and quotation of Italian Ancient States, Provisional Governments, Kingdom of Italy, from 1850 to 1900, with historical background and postal history notes. It is also sold by the Italian Post. Under way the study by Mario Mentaschi and Thomas Mathà, "Letter Mail from and to the Old Italian States 1850-1870", first volume to be published in Italy about international routes and rates relevant to mail from and to the Old Italian States; given the importance of the work the authors have written it in English. Then, two books to fix a new appointment, **MEETING HISTORY**: the new edition of the study by Fabio Bonacina "La salma nascosta" ("The hidden corpse") which deals with last "journey" by Benito Mussolini after Piazzale Loreto, from Cerro Maggiore to Predappio (29/30 August 1957) and, on the occasion of the birth bicentenary of Giuseppe Garibaldi, the "hero of the two worlds", a work written by his son, Ricciotti Garibaldi, about the battle in Drisko "La camicia rossa nella guerra balcanica in Epiro 1912" ("The redshirts in the Balkan war - Campaign in Epirus 1912"), which is accompanied by a rich section of documents.





In "1x1 one by one"

- more than 1200 titles: new and second hand books of Italian and foreign philately, postal history, military post, maritime and air mail, magazines, catalogues, decrees, postal regulations, volumes of history, military history, with the series Mursia and of the Italian Army General Staff, besides several curiosities.

Even this section is constantly updated in the internet site, giving us the possibility to offer new items regularly.

- **55 titles** divided into three classes based on purchases effected. They represent a large discount for those who buy in our "virtual shop" or "by mail".

- a taste of the 20 titles about art, gastronomy, sport, dialect, fiction, local history, folklore, hobbies.

This catalogue with number 25 gives a strange, positive impression!

Twenty-five catalogues of philatelic literature, the first one published in November 1989. In June, we had just formed Edizioni Vaccari s.a.s. with which we officially started our editorial activity, next to our father's commercial one relevant to philately and postal history (he had already started publishing philatelic literature works).

In the present edition, five new books published by our publishing house in 2007. Among classical works, a volume (in Italian, German and English) about the Lombardy-Venetia Kingdom collection of Emil Capellaro by Paolo Vaccari, a real "gem" as it shows, in colour, one of the most important collections in the world. Concerning this, we would like to inform you that the 1x1 sale on page 81 (with 1211 titles) is regularly updated in the internet site; this gives us the possibility to offer you new items regularly.

In the site there are also the periodic sales with special discounts. So, keep an eye on the site!

<u>In the present catalogue</u> there are more than 60 new books, and all the new editions of yearly catalogues, for a total of 627 titles. 55 new offers in the section for free books "in omaggio" on page 108. They represent a large discount for those who buy in our "virtual shop" or "by mail".

The daily news service on-line "Vaccari news" **www.vaccarinews.it**, which started on tiptoe and challenged the traditional philatelic information systems, has now become a daily appointment for many readers. Next year we will celebrate its 5th birthday; we are going to prepare some surprises and we hope that you will like them.
