

Two centuries of Italian contemporary history and military history through over 150 publishers from the great names to the more specialized ones, including the three great sections by the Army General Staff, the Army, Navy and Aviation, all together to testify soldiers' feats.

We are still hearing the echo of celebrations for the 150 years of Italian Unity, and by reading the events which led to the development of a unity profile, from the Old Italian States to the Kingdom of Italy on that 17 March 1861, we can get to know the events, places and people that made Italian national identity possible, from a historical, political, military and cultural, but also personal, point of view.







The **Twentieth century** is fully represented.

Just after 100 years from the beginning of the Great War, several titles tell about the unprecedented proportion of the conflict which exterminated a generation and marked the end of old Europe. Horrors and atrocities which, after just two decades, passing through Fascism and Nazism and Spanish Civil War, were exceeded by the Second World war.

Particularly interesting two chapters, crucial for the Twentieth century: the Eastern border and the Italian colonialism, with great attention to the situation in Africa.

Many titles also in the sections which follow more than 200 years: "Women in history" with women's exploits from the beginning of the Nineteenth to the present century; "Espionage, secrets and mysteries", a collection that reveals many Italian and foreign mysteries, secret services, underhand work along with horrors and truths that have never been told before.

For digital reading lovers, the catalogue can be browsed, just like a magazine, in the **free site Issuu** http://issuu.com/vaccaristamps, with no need of specific programs.

You can enlarge pages, skip them and search what you are looking for automatically, download the pdf file (a fast connection is necessary) and print what you wish. To download the file a subscription is needed, but it is free and easy to complete.

As usual a hardcopy of the catalogue will be issued annually, but the site is regularly updated with the latest new picks of the library market in BOOKS in the specific section "New books", and offers the possibility to search in the whole catalogue by publisher, key word or code.

MEETING HISTORY

For some time Vaccari "HISTORY THROUGH DOCUMENTS" series has continued following a particular guideline: to analyse, through the study of documents and postal history, events or historical topics in an accurate and detailed way thus often revealing details that otherwise would not be easily identifiable.

Among recent publications, the reprint of the work by Ohnmeiss, the history of the sacrifice by the Hero of Italian Risorgimento told through original documents of the time, all of them reproduced.

Within this series, the section "MEETING HISTORY" has been created, which expands on <u>specific historical</u> topics, with a mostly narrative approach, and is always based on the analysis of documents.

The series has been introduced with Fabio Bonacina's study, "La salma nascosta - Mussolini dopo Piazzale Loreto da Cerro Maggiore a Predappio (1946-1957)", 50 years after Mussolini's body was returned to his family, followed by the volume by Ricciotti Garibaldi, "La camicia rossa nella guerra balcanica campagna in Epiro 1912", on the occasion of the bicentenary of the birth of the author's father, Giuseppe Garibaldi.

The third edition is Mario Cobianchi's volume, "Pionieri dell'Aviazione in Italia 1908-1914", which was published in 1943 and had long been difficult to find. This work offers a sort of encyclopaedia on the pioneering of flight in Italy. It has been updated and expanded with numerous notes and an errata at the bottom of the page, edited by Fiorenzo Longhi, one of the greatest experts on Italian aerophilately.

The fourth volume is Rosario Abate and Giorgio Apostolo's work "Caproni in the first world war". Published for the first time in 1970 in Italian, it is available in this new edition also in English. The book retraces the history of the "strategic bomber" and gives a wide sweeping view of the events through new photographs.




The Integrated Therapy Centre for children "La Lucciola" is a rehabilitation structure which gives hospitality to 30 children and young people within the age of 3 and 18 with physical, mental and multiple handicaps: infantile cerebral paralysis, nervous diseases, Down's syndrome and other genetic syndromes, mental retardation, autistic spectrum disorders, disorders in learning and social development.
