FOREWORD

Catalogue no.84 presents the 2,044 lots knocked down at the public auction of Saturday, 12 April.

A new lay-out allows a better consultation: the illustrations are no longer in the tables separately, but they have been placed right in the pages where a description of the relevant lots is present too.

All the lots have been described (some of them also in English in the site) with the greatest care, in a clear and plain way. Quite important is the fact that all those with my signature on them, regardless of whether they come with or without an expert certificate, are absolutely guaranteed with reference to their description, and among them those with a value higher than 500.00 euro come with a Vaccari S.r.l. certificate of guarantee free of charge.

Numerous are the reproductions in our hardcopy catalogue, but all the lots (bulky ones excluded) are reproduced in **our website** www.vaccari.it, in the page devoted to the auction, where it is possible to enlarge images, easily search the items of interest, send bids and finally consult (once the auction is over) a list of unsold lots available for purchase, and the auction returns.

Reproduction are integral part of the description. Having the chance to see them is very important, above all to all those who do not have the opportunity to preview personally the lots of their own interest (at **Milanofil** too, except bulky and literature lots).

Starting prices are particularly interesting; moreover, we do not apply any commission to purchases made at our auctions (usually 20%).

The first lots to be knocked down are Literature ones (703). Only those requested by people present at the sale will be auctioned off in the auction room. Then, the section devoted to Philately and Postal History (1,341).

For several years our auctions of philatelic **Literature** have been a point of reference for those who are looking for the particular volume, the one sold out for a long time, the studies of philately and postal history at heart of any collection, but also that missing "item" to be inserted in one's own library.

The chance to offer such works comes from a continuous commitment in the search and acquisition of stocks and important libraries, work that is part of the company activity, which, over the past 25 years, has been developing a sales department entirely dedicated to books about collecting from all over the world, including a section for second-hand ones and bargains, for the diffusion of philatelic culture.

The philatelic section of the impressive **library "Vito Salierno"** is for sale in this auction. Numerous are the rarities no longer on the market; for example, the volume by Emilio Diena about the postage stamps of Sicily in the original edition of 1904, many works on foreign philately and postal history, some complete collections of magazines and auction catalogues both Italian and foreign.





In **Philately and Postal History**, particularly significant and interesting lots can be found, above all in the section of the Old Italian States, but also of the Italian Kingdom, Social Republic and Republic. Many lots in Risorgimento and Destinations, including mail to Italy, that is "Incoming Mail", with both important and more common items. The chapters with Various subjects and Lots and Collections may give great surprises.

The section devoted to **Air**, **Zeppelin**, **and Rocket mail** proposes an interesting historic overview of both Italian and foreign Aviation. **Space**, after the glories of the American Apollo Flights of the "Enea" collection, auctioned off in December, focuses mainly on USSR/Russia flights, but in the foreground, for the first time so complete, a splendid selection of space letters of the third nation in the world to effect human spaceflights, China, with 14 lots from Shenzhou-1 of 1999 to 9 of 2012.

In the free site **Issuu** http://issuu.com/vaccaristamps, the catalogue can be browsed and it is possible to make surveys inside it, to enlarge single parts, to download the pdf file, to print single pages.

Our auction is present in the international site Delcampe too www.delcampe.net, in the section Prestige.

We are pleased to continue with the traditional **charity initiative**, this year devoted to Fondazione ANT Italia Onlus, which offers free social-health assistance at home to tumour sufferers and deals with cancer prevention projects. Aware of the importance of voluntary work for all of us, the idea is to give our small contribution by donating money but also by diffusing information about the association and its activities. In this auction the returns of three lots will be donated to charity: one cover and two postage stamps of the Italian Risorgimento of the third war for Independence, and two lots relating to the Republican National Guard, a pair of the L.2 of Air Mail with overprint of Brescia, and a full series of Postage due stamps, printing of Brescia, I type.
