Also philately bids Vito Salierno farewell

Besides his expertise in the Islamic culture, his passion for postal history

He has been among the founders of “Milano ‘82”, first world exhibition of philatelic literature

The Italian Islamic community is in mourning. But also the world of philately remembers Vito Salierno, born on 24 August 1934 and passed away yesterday. English professor in secondary schools and then headmaster of the Italian Institute of culture and person in charge to culture at the Italian Embassy in Pakistan, one of the main European experts of the local society, in particular of the poet and philosopher Allama Muhammad Iqbal (since 2007 he was headmaster of the Iqbal Foundation Europe). Besides, he wrote the biography of Gabriele D’Annunzio, and supervised his letters to Barbara Leoni, Fiammadoro and Nietta print editions.

He started writing about postage stamps in 1965, in the “Collezionista”, collaborating, later, for “Filatelia”, “Francobolli” and “Notiziario Asif”. He made a jump in 1975, when, up to 1984, he directed the two-month entitled “Il nuovo corriere filatelico”. For twelve years he has been in the chair of the Commission for postal history of the Fédération internationale de philatélie; since 1975 he has been member of the international jury in the same field and in philatelic literature too. He was secretary of the organizing and of the executive committee of “Milano ‘82”, the first world exhibition of philatelic literature.

Considerable was his editorial engagement. Only in the specific philatelic field, we must mention, as examples, “Il fascino discreto della posta e del francobollo”, “Manuale di filatelia” and the series, arrived to the seventh volume, “Bibliografia filatelica e storico-postale ragionata”. As far as Vaccari as a publisher is concerned, here are “La censura postale in Lombardia” (Postal censorship in Lombardy), “La posta austriaca a Roma” (The Austrian Post in Rome), “Le relazioni postali dell’Italia nell’Ottocento. Italia-Svizzera” (Postal relations of Italy in 1800s. Italy-Switzerland) and “Le relazioni postali dell’Italia nell’Ottocento. Italia-Francia” (Postal relations of Italy in 1800s. Italy-France).

For several years our auctions of philatelic **Literature** have been a point of reference for those who are looking for the particular volume, the one sold out for a long time, the studies of philately and postal history at heart of any collection, but also that missing “item” to be inserted in one’s own library.

The chance to offer such works comes from a continuous commitment in the search and acquisition of stocks and important libraries, work that is part of the company activity, which, over the past 25 years, has been developing a sales department entirely dedicated to books about collecting from all over the world, including a section for second-hand ones and bargains, for the diffusion of philatelic culture.
