AIR MAIL - ZEPPELIN - ROCKET - SPACE

The section devoted to **Air**, **Zeppelin**, **and Rocket mail** proposes an interesting historic overview of both Italian and foreign Aviation.

Space, after the glories of the American Apollo Flights of the "Enea" collection, auctioned off in December, focuses mainly on **USSR/Russia** flights, but in the foreground, for the first time so complete, a splendid selection of space letters of the third nation in the world to effect human spaceflights, **CHINA**, with **14 lots from Shenzhou-1 of 1999 to 9 of 2012**.

Italy - 1933 - Air Mail State Service - Triptych of the North Atlantic Cruise L.5,25+44,75 Sassone n.1 - P.V. - Merone (cert.2012) lot 933 - BASE euro 1.600,00



Norway/USA - 1926 - first flight over the North Pole by airplane - Commander Richard E.Byrd - pilot Floyd Bennet - the two pilots, in advance of 3 days of Nobile enterprise, left from Kings Bay on 9.5.1926 in order to conquer the North Pole by means of a plane, and, after a 15 hours flight, they reached the Pole and returned to the base, after a 1,360 miles journey - cover sent to East Orange with a Norwegian franking of 0.15+20 and USA c.2 Yvert n.105+106+229 with relevant cancellations of Kings Bay and NY-Alesund of 9.5.1926 - A.Bolaffi (financial cert. "Gorgeous" 2005)

USSR - 1982 - orbital station Salyut-7 - space letter of Soyuz T-6 flight - private mail Earth-Space letter (2 typewritten sheets without date), by the Directors of the Lower Secondary School N.2 in Enen and of the party officials in Komsomol, addressed to Commander Anatoli Berezovoy, former pupil of the school, and to cosmonaut Valentin Lebedev, aboard the space station Salyut-7 - cover carried on 24.6.1982 aboard Soyuz T-6, canc.
