Thanks to the traditional **charity initiative** connected to the auction, from 2008 it has been possible to donate a **total amount of 27,250.00 euro**.

They have started in 2008, with 3,800.00 euro to AIRC (the Italian Association for Research on Cancer). Then, in 2009, 2,400.00 euro to "Vip - Viviamo in positivo" (association in Modena for clowntherapy); in 2010, 5,000.00 to the international Francesca Rava Foundation; in 2011, 4,000.00 to ASEOP (Paediatric Oncology Haematology Support Association); in 2012, 5,500.00 to ANT Italia (Italian National Foundation for Tumour Sufferers Assistance); in 2013, 4,150.00 to "Tutti insieme a Rovereto e Sant'Antonio", an association engaged in the reconstruction after the earthquake in the province of Modena; in 2014, 2,400.00 to ANT Italia Onlus.

This time, one of the lots will be selected at the end of the auction and its return given to the non-profit Fondazione ANT Italia, Delegation of the District of Vignola (Modena), which offers free social-health assistance at home to tumour sufferers and deals with cancer prevention projects, a reality Vaccari has been cooperating with for some years.

Relevant information will be published together with auction results.

#### **NATIONAL PROFILE**

From 1985 up to now, Fondazione ANT Italia Onlus **has assisted, completely free of charge**, more than 106,000 tumour sufferers (datum updated to 31 December 2014). In 9 different Italian regions, there are currently about 4,300 patients receiving daily home care by 20 teams of ANT healthcare operators providing, for Sufferers and their Families, all the necessary hospital and social assistance.

A total of about 400 **healthcare Professionals** (doctors, nurses, psychologists, nutritionists, physiotherapists, pharmacists, social-health workers and other employees) work for the Foundation together with about 1,800 **Volunteers**, enrolled in the ANT register.

The support faces every kind of problems in the perspective of "global healthcare" of Sufferers.





Furthermore, ANT is strongly committed to **cancer prevention**, with projects of early diagnosis of skin cancer, thyroid tumours, gynaecological and breast neoplasia.

Just within the Skin cancer Project, that started in 2004, 104,000 patients have been visited in 70 different Italian provinces (datum updated to 31 December 2014).

The campaigns of prevention are carried out both in healthcare structures offered free of charge to ANT, and in the ANT clinics, and also inside the mobile clinic - the Prevention BUS. The vehicle, equipped with advanced diagnostic instruments (digital mammogram, ultrasound scanner and video dermatoscope), allows to make prevention visits locally, for the various ANT projects.

Fondazione ANT collects about 22 million euro per year. In 2013, ANT financed its activities thanks to the donations of private individuals and to the organized fundraising events (56%), to the contribution of the 5x1000 (11%), to bequests and donations (7%), and only in a small part to public funds (18%). In the assignation of the 5x1000, ANT is the  $10^{th}$  non-profit organization in the Italian national list among over 35,000 entitled in the same field. As far as the destination of funds is concerned, again in 2013, 18% was used for the organization of fundraising events, and 76% for the institutional activities.

Fondazione ANT operates in Italy through **120 Delegations**, where the presence of Volunteers is very active. The duties of Delegations are, at local level, the initiatives of awakening and fundraising and the arrangement of the planning necessary to healthcare assistance at home.

#### **DELEGATION OF VIGNOLA (MODENA)**

In the District of Vignola the Foundation has been present for over twenty years. At present, the medical team of ODO-ANT (Oncological Home Hospital) Vignola - made up of two doctors, two nurses and one psychologist - is active in all the province of Modena. In 2014, 89 tumour sufferers have been cared at home and completely free of charge (35 people every day - datum updated to 31 December 2014). From 1992 up to now, over 2,200 sufferers have been cared for by ANT in the whole province. On the front of cancer prevention, in the scope of early diagnosis of skin cancer, since 2007 in the province of Modena, 24,860 free visits have been made.
