

The great satisfaction we feel is a reward for all the efforts needed to keep the high standard of the articles proposed. And that, not only thanks to the several national and international awards, but above all thanks to the expressions of appreciation coming from the collecting world. And great satisfaction is expressed even by the Authors. They can be sure that what they have written will have a privileged spreading, since our target is readers at a very advanced level. Moreover, even our internet circulation (www.vaccarimagazine.it) make our readers number larger and larger.

Among the articles proposed in this issue, there are some which are really important: the complex study about postal rates between Italian States, Kingdom of Italy and Scandinavian countries; the deep study about Papal State letters unfranked or insufficiently franked; postal frauds and badly cut postage stamps, to understand when it is correct to talk about frauds.

And more: the postage stamps by Tommaso Aloysio Juvara; ordinary mail stamps from June 1944 to June 1946; another part of the analysis about the Vatican City stamps; the Russian Post introduced in 1920; mail between Naples and Sicily during Garibaldi's dictatorship.

But there are not only known Authors; even new ones, who have written, for example, about the strange use of the "déboursé" postmark or about delivery of valuables in the Duchy of Modena.

Next to traditional philately, an interesting article about a topical subject which has been asked for by several collectors: overprinted stamps, created to satisfy different needs and situations.

From this issue on, the column "Biblioteca" will propose only suggestions edited by "Vaccari news - philately in real time", the daily service of news on-line by Vaccari srl.

Again at the site www.vaccarinews.it, there are news about current and topical events; in a six-monthly Magazine, they could not have the immediacy they require.
