FOREWORD

Philately and Postal History are present in this public auction, with 1,004 lots, postage stamps unused and used, on piece or on cover, covers, letters and postal documents more or less important but equally interesting, a good typological variety of lots able to catch your attention.

Italian classic material, Vaccari specialization, is mainly represented, together with many other fields too. As an example, in the section devoted to the Old Italian States, for Lombardy Venetia Kingdom, a newspaper (lot 59), the "Illustrirte Zeitung" from Leipzig of 3 December 1864, with postage-due label for newspapers kr.1 black, cancelled with "I.R. Dogana Principale di Verona"; it is of very good quality and really rare in these conditions. For Sicily, one strip of 4 (lot 311) of very good quality of 1/2 grano, first plate, Naples paper, dark orange, on a letter from Messina to Naples of 24 May 1859; the four postage stamps are cancelled with the horse-shoe postmark.

Then, there is a letter insured for L.4000 (lot 566) from Brescia to Manerba (BS) of 20 December 1943, during the Italian Social Republic period, franked with an example on its own of GNR L.50 violet, Brescia printing, with overprint of the first type; it is the first day of use, on the whole also of a very good quality.

Again with reference to the Italian area, besides preadhesive, Risorgimento, Italian Kingdom, Italian Social Republic and Regency, Italian Republic, considerable are the sections devoted to Italian post offices abroad, colonies, occupations and military mail. Remarkable is also the part regarding foreign countries, peculiar destinations or mail "incoming" in Italy. There are also various subjects, varieties, air mail, both Italian and foreign, and Zeppelin, sea routes, postal stationery, disinfection, collecting offices and fiscal stamps.

As usual, the chapter with Lots and Collections may give great surprises, particularly well-accepted. Then, two lots, 941 and 984.

The first one is relevant to the Kingdom of Italy: collection "Study for the sheet plating of the c.20/1862 postage stamp of Italy perforated", collection that, so as it is, has received high recognitions at exhibitions with competition.

The second one is a collection about the colour shades of the IV issue of Sardinia, a very interesting gathering, result of a passionate research lasted many years, with a considerable quantity of examples with valuable/rare colours, with generally good/commercial quality with few defective examples.

There are no sections devoted to rocket mail and Space, to postcards or philatelic literature, that sometimes come with Vaccari auctions and that will distinguish the ones of 2016.

Anyway, browse the catalogue to realize personally how much this sale offers, taking into consideration that all **descriptions** (some of them also in English in the site) have been made with the greatest care, both for more and less important lots. Moreover, the lots with Paolo Vaccari initials or signature on them, regardless of whether they come with or without an expert certificate, are absolutely guaranteed with reference to their description; this is a considerable factor in order to purchase in complete serenity. Moreover, among them, **lots with a value higher than 500.00 euro come with a Vaccari S.r.l. certificate of guarantee free of charge**.





Coming back to descriptions, you will certainly notice that the initials BB/BBB/GM/BM/BD etc., are no more present, that they have been replaced by a terminology even more pertinent to the quality of lots on their whole, to help in understanding descriptions more precisely: mixed quality (when there are both perfect and defective examples); usual quality (when there are neither defects nor examples of a good/very good quality); good quality (from good to very good quality); very good quality (when quality - as the term itself says - is very good and/or gorgeous). In the use of this terminology the whole is taken into consideration with regard to freshness, centring, postmarking and whatever may coincide with the quality fixed.

Reproductions are integral part of the description and are placed side by side to it.

All the lots (except for bulky ones) are reproduced in the **web site** www.vaccari.it. Searching the items of interest, sending bids directly, consulting (once the auction is over) the list of possible lots unsold and available at the starting price until 14 December and the auction returns: all that can be made in the site. The version of the catalogue to be browsed is in the free site **Issuu** http://issuu.com/vaccaristamps. Moreover, the auction is present in Delcampe international site www.delcampe.net, in the Prestige section.

The viewing of lots will be possible on the occasion of Italiafil in Florence on 23 and 24 October (bulky ones excluded, except for lots 941, 971 and 984) by Vaccari stand, and, afterwards, by Vaccari auction room (11-13 November upon appointment - on the 14th from 8:15 a.m. - local time). Mail, fax, e-mail, or internet bids will be accepted until Friday 13 November - 3 p.m. (local time). Then the auction will be held publicly by Vaccari auction room on Saturday, obviously taking into consideration all the bids arrived until the day before. Mail bids will be dealt with by Paolo Vaccari personally. (The lots purchased can be collected, only on demand, also at Veronafil on Friday 27 and Saturday 28 November.)

A usual, no commission is applied to purchases made at Vaccari auctions (usually 20%).
