"Gift books", a gift for your purchases from the Bookshops, are constantly updated. There are always new books to choose among and what is proposed in this catalogue is the offer of the moment. Different titles are then cyclically inserted. Therefore, we suggest you to often visit this section, to create your own discount "ad hoc". Just keep in mind to select your gift book at the moment of your order and it will be sent to you free.







In the site only there is the "1x1" sale section, devoted to second hand items and bargains, with new and second hand, ancient and rare books, magazines, catalogues, further to numerous curiosities. One copy only is almost always available by title; so... "first come, first satisfied!"



All the titles proposed in this catalogue are obviously introduced **on-line** too, in a clear and simple, but also exhaustive way, thanks to the extensive cards with detailed descriptions, introductions, tables of contents and all that can help in the choice of the volume. For every title you can find many pieces of information, and also the link to the review published in our daily web magazine "Vaccari news - philately in real time", enriched by further ideas, connections, interviews with the authors, and much more.





In the "Philatelic Bookshop", among **new books**, a work published by Vaccari is present too: "**AEROFILIA ITALIANA 1884-1920**. From the Pioneers of Aviation to the "Aces" of the Great War. CATALOGUE OF AVIATION POSTMARKS. Pioneering period, Italian-Turkish Conflict, First World War" (in Italian) with point valuations, by Fiorenzo Longhi, one of the main experts of this field, and author of numerous successful works. Next to the proper cataloguing, you can find a deep analysis of the military-historical situation for every period and hundreds of colour images.

As regards the "History Bookshop", after the sale campaign for the closing of the proper catalogue, we have decided to keep and insert, together with the texts of the "Philatelic Bookshop", some titles of military history particularly sought-after. This means a change, keeping a wide selection of the volumes by the three Italian General Staffs, Army, Navy and Air Force, thus offering a heritage of historical and military-historical information strictly connected to philately and postal history.

Following the same concept, other titles about history are proposed, of great interest and hard to be found in bookshops, and also the titles by Vaccari of the series "meeting History", volumes richly illustrated that analyze specific historical themes, starting from the study of documents.

Among magazines, the six monthly "Vaccari Magazine", a collector's magazine, one of the most awarded of the field at international level, proposes, since 1989, important studies about philately, traditional and not.
