Vaccari public auction of philately and postal history, with 1,004 lots of covers and postage stamps of different type and period, has taken place in Vignola (Mo) on Saturday 14 November 2015, by the auction room of Vaccari srl, via M.Buonarroti 46.

Auctioneer Luca Lopez. Mail offers were dealt with by Paolo Vaccari.

Among people in the auction room, people on the phone, and those who had sent their bids by e-mail, post, fax or through the site, a very high percentage of lots has had a buyer: 57%. The percentage increase of the starting price has been of 32%.

Well or very well the Old Italian States, except for the Kingdom of Sardinia. The best was Naples followed by Modena. As to the rest, there was a general good interest, also for foreign items.

Attention for Italian postage stamps, particularly for those of the Nineteenth century, came above all from foreign clients from North America, Europe including Russia, Asia, Egypt and Australia; nothing from Central and South America.
