FOREWORD

In the public auction sale of Saturday 30 April, presented in this catalogue no.89, 1,285 lots of philately, postal history and postcards will be knocked down.

In the section devoted to **Philately and Postal History**, 990 are the lots that range from "various subjects" to foreign destinations and/or mail to Italy, that is "Incoming Mail". Moreover, there are Preadhesive and Old Italian States, among which different rarities stand out in an absolute sense. As an example the letter sent from Parma franked for 30 centimes with pair of cent.15 tête-bêche (lot 137), and, again of Parma but in the Provisional Government period, the letter with pair of cent.5 yellow green corresponding to the military rate (lot 148). Modena is present with different letters franked with "typographic errors" coming from a famous collection. In Naples, very good lots such as Trinacria and different Crocette, one of which (lot 104) on a circular letter sent to Tropea! Very good proposals also for the other Italian States.

Regarding the Italian Kingdom, one cent.20/1862 unused with gum, sheet integral corner, with registration holes and frame line (lot 259). Also the modern section, such as Italian Republic and S.Marino, is provided with good material. Generally speaking, interesting items can be found in single lots, but in bulky ones too.

Among **Air mail**, the 2 Zeppelin lots of rare availability (731 and 732) stand out. As usual in Vaccari Spring auctions, the section devoted to **Space** is represented: it starts with the rarest moon space letter, Apollo 16 (lot 741) example n.17 of 25, and continues with a beautiful overview of space mail USSR-RUSSIA largely flown and an ISS rarity, one of the 11 official postcards sent for the first time from the International Space Station (lot 785).

Also 295 lots of **Postcards** category are back in this auction, offering a general overview that focuses on Aviation (both in the specific section and in Regionalism) and on lots, with a large selection of thousands of postcards (above all Regionalism of whole Italy and Military) at very competitive prices!

The lots of the section devoted to Postcards will be knocked down first, followed by Philately and Postal History. During the course of the public auction, the offers received by correspondence (via mail, fax, e-mail, internet) within Friday 29 April (3:00 p.m. local time) are managed and evaluated together with those of live participants, in the auction room or on the phone.

It is important to bear in mind, when deciding one's own "price ceiling" for a specific lot, that **no commission has** been applied to purchases made at Vaccari auctions (usually 20%) for over 20 years.

All descriptions (some of them also in English in the site) have been made with the greatest care and in a clear way. The lots with the initials or signature by Paolo Vaccari, regardless of whether they come with or without an expert certificate, are absolutely guaranteed with reference to their description; this is a relevant factor in order to purchase in complete serenity. Among them, those with a value higher than 500.00 euro come with a Vaccari S.r.l. certificate of guarantee free of charge.

Reproductions are integral part of the description. In the hardcopy catalogue, the numerous reproductions are included in the pages carrying the relevant descriptions.

All the lots (bulky ones excluded) are reproduced in the **web site** <u>www.vaccari.it</u>, in the page devoted to the auction, and images can be enlarged by simply clicking on them; searching the items of interest, sending bids directly, consulting (once the auction is over) the list of possible lots unsold and available at the starting price until 14 June and the auction returns: everything is very easy in the site.

Enlargements are possible also in the version to be browsed in the free site **Issuu** http://issuu.com/vaccaristamps, that gives the chance to make researches, to enlarge single parts, to download the pdf file on one's computer, to print single pages.

Moreover, the auction is in Delcampe international site www.delcampe.net, in the Prestige section.

The viewing of lots will be possible by Vaccari auction room from 27 April, upon appointment. (The lots purchased can be collected, only on demand, also at Veronafil on Friday 27 and Saturday 28 May.)

USA - 1972 - **APOLLO 16** - space letter **n.17 out of 25** that Charles M.Duke included in his "Personal Preference Kit" during Apollo 16 mission - franked with two halves of the diptych "A decade of Space achievements" c.8+c.8, canc. "Kennedy Space Center, FL Apr 16 PM 1972", launch day, and canc. of the ship Ticonderoga board post office, 27.4.1972, recovery day - in the upper part of the cover, the astronaut's handwritten text and signature: "I certify that cover 17 of a total of 25 carried on the Apollo 16 flight landed on the Moon, approved for storage in my P.P.K. Charles Duke"



guarantee declaration by C.M.Duke issued on 29.7.1985 in the presence of an American notary public - A.Bolaffi (financial cert. 100% with expertise appendix 1986) - Enzo Diena (cert.1986) - the Apollo 16 is last mission of Apollo flights authorized to carry mail and the 25 space letters carried from 16 to 27.4.1972 by Young, Mattingly and Duke are last ones to reach the Moon and are considered to be the rarest Moon space letters
