In this “Philatelic Bookshop” 34, even three works signed Vaccari are introduced among **new publications**.

In the 90th anniversary of the Expedition to conquer the North Pole, an adventurous and charming journey narrated by Emilio Milisenda in “Umberto Nobile and «Norge» transpolar flight. History, mail, documents and memorabilia”, by means of more than 450 images of philatelic and complementary documents: photos, postcards, air letters, telegrams, invitations, menus, magazines, postage stamps, vignettes, cancellations, medals, calendars, ...

Giuseppe Buffagni, as a result of very numerous findings, has prepared the new edition of “Catalogue of postmarks 2016” in use in the Este Duchy from the fourth volume of “The Post in the Este Territories. History and Postal History - 1453-1852”. New postmarks, numerous handwritten marks of the various places and additional or complementary postmarks. Considerable are the changes relevant to the colours of inks used, to the periods of use, but especially to “first date known” or to “last date known”.

Daniele Prudenzano worked instead at “The New Gaggero. Catalogue of the squared circle cancellations of the Kingdom of Italy 2016”, due in November. This second edition proposes more than 1,200 new findings (8,199 the postmarks catalogued); numerous are the additional pieces of information to make the work even better.

Among magazines, the six-monthly “**Vaccari Magazine**”, that successfully represented Italy at the very recent “World stamp show” in New York being awarded the large vermeil. Since years it has become one of the most awarded magazines of the field at international level, thanks to the high quality of its graphics and layout and to the importance of studies on philately, traditional and not, proposed since 1989. At <http://issuu.com/vaccaristamps> the analytical index with all the articles published (divided by subject, author, magazine), a bibliographical instrument extremely appreciated by all scholars and collectors.

The “**1x1**” sale section, being most of the books in single copy only, that is assigned to the first applicant, is always changing and is therefore on-line only. Devoted to second hand items and bargains, with new and second hand, ancient and rare books, magazines, catalogues, further to numerous curiosities, it is periodically enriched with really interesting proposals: much sought-after and rare volumes, usually present only in philatelic literature auctions.

By subscribing to our “**Mailing list**” (in the upper right side of the home page in our site www.vaccari.it), or by clicking “Mi piace” in our **Facebook** page (www.facebook.com/VaccariFilatelia), you are always informed about all the updates, the offers and the news.

And among novelties there is also “**Vaccari Shop**”, a new Facebook page (www.facebook.com/VaccariShop) that proposes, on a daily basis, not only items of postal history, postage stamps and lots, classic material of extra quality, items for auction sales, but also a varied choice from the editorial sector, ranging from the latest philatelic publications, to classic philatelic books, ending with discounts. A social-shop in which you can interact with fans, express comments, add “like” and all that makes a meeting place out of a simple shop-window.
