FOREWORD

In the public auction sale of Saturday 12 November, presented in this catalogue no.90, 1,100 lots of philately and postal history will be knocked down.

Very interesting is the Italian classic material, which Vaccari is specialist in, and all the Italian area in general.

Attention has to be called, for Lombardy Venetia, to the 10 soldi brown of the first type on a letter from Perarolo to Venice of 1st November 1858, the first day of use (lot 88); for Naples, to a unique letter from Chieti to Lanciano of 8 October 1860 with two examples of 2 grana of the third plate carmine rose cancelled with the postmark "CHIETI 8 TTO. 1860" repeated alongside (lot 210); and, for the Papal State, to a combination unique and of very good quality: two letters from Ferentino to Rome of 4 and 9 November 1870, one franked with c.10+10 of 1868, the other one with c.10 of 1868 and Italy c.10 printing of Turin, both with rouletting lozenge cancellation and, alongside, double circle of Ferentino with pen date (lot 314).

Very rich is the section of the Italian Kingdom. In the period of King Vittorio Emanuele II, for example, a rare example of very good quality and centring: the 10 centesimi brownish orange, position 14 of the sheet (lot 508). In addition to the Italian States and Kingdom, other sections are devoted to preadhesive, Risorgimento, Italian Social Republic and Regency, Italian Republic, Trieste, Italian post offices abroad, colonies, occupations and military.

Well represented is also the part with peculiar destinations or mail "incoming" in Italy and the foreign section where the first segment of the "Europe Collection 1840-1955" is introduced, with countries, in alphabetical order, from A to I, 51 lots of postage stamps used and/or unused at very interesting prices. (The second segment J-Z will be inserted in our next auction of Spring 2017.)

There are also various subjects and curiosities, varieties, air mail, in particular the triptychs of the Decennial Cruise, sea route, postal stationery, disinfection, railways...

Appreciated surprises in the section of Lots and Collections, with some offers of postcards and decrees too.

As usual for over 20 years, **no commission is applied to purchases made at Vaccari auctions (normally 20/22%)**, and this is an important matter to bear in mind, when deciding one's own "price ceiling".

Another very important factor is that the lots with Paolo Vaccari initials or signature, regardless of whether they come with or without an expert certificate, are absolutely guaranteed with reference to their description and, among them, those with a value higher than 500.00 euro come with a Vaccari S.r.l. certificate of guarantee free of charge.

Descriptions (some of them also in English in the site) have been made with the greatest care and in a clear way for all lots and **reproductions** are integral part. Numerous are the images reproduced in the pages of the hardcopy catalogue, carrying the relevant descriptions, but all the lots (some bulky ones only excluded) are reproduced in the **web site** www.vaccari.it, in the page devoted to the auction.

In the site, researches can be easily made as per the version to be browsed in the free site **Issuu** http://issuu.com/vaccaristamps, that give the chance to download the pdf file on one's computer.

Sending bids directly, consulting (once the auction is over) the list of possible lots unsold and available at the starting price until 12 December and the auction returns: all that can be made in the site.

Regarding the site, 20 years have passed since, exactly in October 1996, it was inaugurated, already giving the possibility of making on-line purchases (a real technological revolution).

The viewing of lots will be possible on the occasion of Italiafil in Bologna on 21 and 22 October (excluding boxed bulky items of the "lots" section) and, afterwards, by Vaccari auction room (9-11 November upon appointment - on the 12th from 8:15 a.m. - local time).

Mail, fax, e-mail, or internet bids will be accepted until Friday 11 November - 5 p.m. (local time).

Then the auction will be held publicly by Vaccari auction room on Saturday, obviously taking into consideration all the bids arrived until the day before. Mail bids will be dealt with by Paolo Vaccari personally. The lots purchased can be collected, only on demand, also at Veronafil on Friday 25 and Saturday 26 November.
