FOREWORD

One **novelty** in this auction, whose 1,213 lots of philately and postal history will be knocked down publicly on Saturday 23 June: in addition to the customary methods of participation, i.e. sending mail bids, asking for telephone bids or participating in person, **LIVE bidding** will be feasible, upon registration and approval, comfortably sitting in front of one's own computer. Live auction will be easy to follow, watching lots scroll through and listening to the auctioneer, and bidding as if you were present in the auction room. The only constraint is a fast internet connection.

This catalogue no.93 contains the sectors we have been representing for years, Italy and foreign countries from preadhesive up to present days, but certainly large and very interesting are the sections that reflect our specialisations.

Starting from Italian States with postal history and numerous postage stamps of good and very good quality, among which some prestigious examples, I point out, just as an example, lots 43 and 63 of Lombardy Venetia, 93 and 109 of Modena, lots 135 and 182 included in the wide proposal of Naples and Naples Provinces, 199 for Parma, 218 of Papal State, lots 313 and 342 of Sicily and 361 of Tuscany; in general, all the Italian States are well represented and a beautiful group can be found among Lots and Collections at no.1103.

In Risorgimento, 66 lots concern Veneto and Mantua area in 1866; among these ones 407, 410, 417, 426 and 430 stand out, but all are prominent.

Very developed is the part devoted to the Kingdom of Italy, among which lots 636 and 653, as an example, are notable.

With regard to Italian Colonies, I point out lot 742 for Italian East Africa, and, among Lots and Collections, I suggest the viewing of 1115. Among Italian Occupations and Military, a fine gathering relevant to the Polish Corpse (lot 767).

Particularly remarkable in the section focused on Foreign countries are lot 1042 (France) and 1066 (Great Britain).

Wide overview of Air, Zeppelin and Space mail with 193 lots.

We start with great Italian aviators, such as De Pinedo, Lombardi and Balbo, and their exceptional aircraft enterprises in chronological order, among which some great rarities, e.g. lots 822, 846, 858. For the year 1928, one Special Umberto Nobile for the 90th anniversary of "Italia" airship, 5 lots (825-829) among which the newspaper la "Banchisa" n.5 and one wonderful documentary collection stand out.

Next up Foreign countries: important lot 893, present also 2 lots devoted to the exploration of Antarctica by Byrd (897 and 898).

More than 50 the lots of Zeppelin mail, among which Italian Colonies and Vatican undoubtedly distinguish themselves with covers not in circulation for a long time such as the triple mixed franking of Vatican-Italy-Germany of 1930 (lot 920) and also a new finding (lot 930).

For most, lots of Air and Zeppelin mail are accompanied by Fiorenzo Longhi certificates.

Regarding Space, many signatures, two lots also in complete sheets, the varieties of American postage stamps and an Italian one, further to space letters USSR, RUSSIA and ISS up to 2018.

Lots can be viewed on Friday 25 and on Saturday 26 May at Veronafil (bulky lots in album or box excluded, except for nos. 767, 1103 and 1115); from Wednesday 20 June all by our seat (20-22 June upon appointment - on the 23th from 8:15 a.m. local time).

Bids and requests for participation, made by those who will not be in person at the public auction on Saturday 23 June, will be accepted (by mail, fax, e-mail and internet) **until 5 p.m. (local time) of Friday 22 June.**



To decide one's own bid, I suggest to bear the following in mind:

- at Vaccari auctions **no commission is applied to buyers' return prices (generally 20/22%)**;
- the lots with my initials or signature, regardless of whether they come with or without an expert certificate, are absolutely guaranteed with reference to their description and, **among them, those with a value higher than 500.00 euro come with a Vaccari S.r.l. certificate of guarantee free of charge.**

Descriptions (some of them also in English in the site) have been made with the greatest care and clarity and **reproductions** (numerous in the hardcopy version of the catalogue, but **in our web-site** www.vaccari.it all lots are reproduced, only some bulky ones excluded) are integral part of them.

Directly from our site, you can send your bids, see (once the auction is over) the list of auction returns and possible lots unsold and available at the starting price until 23 July.
