## **FOREWORD**

A new catalogue with numerous net price proposals, devoted both to **postage stamps** and to **postal history**, with items suitable to different kinds of collections, both from a perspective of collecting topic choice and economically. There are items a bit for all the fields of interest of the **Italian area**: Italian States, Kingdom of Italy, R.S.I. and Regency, Italian Republic, Trieste AMG-VG and Colonies. And also for any budget: from copies a little more peculiar to enrich one's own collection to more common, but of no less concern, ones, with a wide choice of types and cancellations.

It starts with postage stamps, all fully reproduced in the initial plates and described in the subsequent pages, and it continues with postal history, covers and documents whose reproductions show descriptive texts alongside. The online version obviously offers more flexibility regarding the possibility to visualize all the complete images, even enlarging them, and the constant updates of actual availability. In some cases there is one example (clearly pointed out) of similar or of equal quality items, but for the most part lots are unique and assigned to the first request, arrived by filling the order form or simply putting the item of one's own interest in the cart in our site (www.vaccari.it).

If you wish to run **researches** in the site, you can click on the entry "**Stamps and lots**" or "**Postal history**"; looking for a specific lot, by means of "search in the site" you must enter the numeric code followed by "FOG" for postage stamps and by "FOG\_SP" for postal history, selecting "Philately" in both cases.

In all the versions of this catalogue, in support of collectors, there are clear indications about the different qualities and comparative examples of the same are supplied too; quality is given in the description of every single item. Moreover, lots with a value higher than 500.00 euro come with a **Vaccari S.r.l. certificate of guarantee** free of charge.

In the printed version **accessories** for collecting are proposed too, in order to value and customize one's collection, with sheets, pockets, folders, albums, files. And there are also **packets of mixed stamps** (animals, landscapes, monuments, characters, history, geography, art and culture) to discover the world by means of postage stamps. Both sections are in the site.

If what you wish is not in this catalogue, send your request to info@vaccari.it or, in the site, search in the various sections of "Philately" periodically updated. You may find items missing to your collection also under heading "Price Lists".

Price lists of postage stamps are divided into three groups: in the first one, Italian States, Provisional Governments and Kingdom of Italy until 1900 with King Vittorio Emanuele II (17.3.1861-9.1.1878) and King Umberto I (9.1.1878-29.7.1878); in the second one the Kingdom of Italy from King Vittorio Emanuele III (29.7.1900-9.5.1946), R.S.I. and Regency; in the third one the Italian Republic (first period).
