"Of course, times are different from then", they explain. "Many factors have changed, starting with the previously unknown digitization. However, our effort is constant: always try to adapt to what customers want, without sacrificing quality. Quality understood in full: in the contents of the publications, obviously, but also in the more technical aspects, the productive ones. Because an interesting volume is better appreciated if it is presented as it should be". "Another aspect that distinguishes us is the desire to always offer insights in new sectors, not sufficiently valued, or to favour, thanks to further studies, discoveries that integrate or even question what was believed. That's the beauty of philately!"

"The distribution also continues, through the catalogue «Philatelic Library» -a reference point for years on the editorial productions of the sector-, of works on various aspects related to collecting published in Italy and abroad, because it is essential to know what is collected and is the object of one's passion. A passion that we like to share by meeting people at trade meetings but also in merely cultural events or in other areas to introduce philately. Moreover, thanks to social media, it is possible to reach a wider audience and perhaps «new collectors will be born»"!

Remaining in the sector closely linked to books, two relevant anniversaries concern the two periodicals, the six-monthly "Vaccari Magazine" (30) and the daily web-magazine "Vaccari news" (15), for which a dedicated postcard was prepared. In conjunction with Veronafil on 23 November 2018, the international competition of philatelic literature "Italia 2018" was also held: both were awarded with the large gold medal! The volume by Alberto Barcella and Pietro Amorelli "Scattered Papers. Garibaldine correspondences by and to Ippolito Nievo. Insights into Sicilian postal history. 1859-1861", tells the story of an extraordinary period, which preceded the Unity of Italy on the island, and the effects of revolution on the postal system through the analyses of the correspondence of a brilliant and idealist young man who spent last months of his life in Sicily following Garibaldi's troops.



THE ITALIAN KINGDOM REFORM OF 1863 (in Italian)

The volume by Gianluigi Maria Forti, "The Postal Reform of 1863 in the Kingdom of Italy. A book-research really exhaustive, all the transformations that regulations have undergone in the years before and after 1863 directly from the original texts, a deep investigation on this important historical moment in a new way.






SQUARED CIRCLE POSTMARKS CATALOGUE (in Italian)

Last edition of "Il nuovo Gaggero 2016. Catalogue of squared circle postmarks of the Kingdom of Italy" by Daniele Prudenzano: more than 1,200 new findings (now 8,204 included); all the postmarks seen and known, with their first and last year of use recorded; separation of the writing of the upper and lower crown; a wide introduction; a very useful index of places; point valuations.

ESTE POSTMARKS CATALOGUE (in Italian)

Following several new findings, the new edition of the catalogue of marks relevant to the Este Duchy from the fourth volume of "The Post in the Este territories and in the Duchy of Modena. History and postal history 1453-1852" by Giuseppe Buffagni. New postmarks, several handwritten marks of the different offices and complementary postmarks. Main variations refer to colours of ink used, to periods of use, but above all to "first date known" or "last date known".

AEROFILIA ITALIANA (in Italian)

The historical descriptive catalogue of Italian air force postmarks by Fiorenzo Longhi, "Aerofilia italiana 1884-1920. From the Pioneers of Aviation to the Aces of the Great War": 1,423 postmarks listed with their rarity point evaluations, 607 illustrations, 240 pages rich in information also relevant to aviation history. Within the Italian-Turkish Conflict, the flysheets in Arab language translated into Italian. During World War I, the presence of the Italian aviation units in other countries and of the allied aviation forces of France and Great Britain in Italy.
