Another aspect that distinguishes us is the desire to always offer insights in new sectors, not sufficiently valued, or to favour, thanks to further studies, discoveries that integrate or even question what was believed. That's the beauty of philately!

The distribution also continues, through the present catalogue "Philatelic Library", a reference point for years on the editorial productions of the sector, of works on various aspects related to collecting published in Italy and abroad, because it is essential to know what is collected and is the object of one's passion.

In the current edition no.37 we have maintained choices made last year to facilitate and make more and more immediate the identification of the volume of interest, so that readers can be easily untangled among the hundreds of titles available.

The printed version is easy to read and provides an overview of volumes and catalogues about collecting, last year's novelties, the books that kindled more interest, those necessary as reference texts.

The on-line version takes advantage of the possibilities offered by the site: although there are so many titles, three times more than the paper version, thanks to a clear division into categories and the search function it is very easy to find what you looked for or have an overview on what published on the subject. Moreover, the site can be constantly updated with the latest news and can contain detailed files with presentations, indexes and specific information.

Some categories are only on-line, in order to be able to provide information on actual availability at any time. For example, the section devoted to the publications of the Italian High Commands of Army, Navy and Air Force, available until sold out and at promotional prices.

We advise to visit the site frequently, since, besides new entries, discounts, special offers on-line only and gift books to create one's own ad hoc discount are updated exclusively in the site.

In this catalogue, "gift books" are included: according to the total amount reached with your purchases, you can select your gift. And a further gift, reserved to the six-monthly "Vaccari Magazine" subscribers, is the additional discount of 10% on all titles (except for books already promoted).

The "1x1" sale section, instead, is only on-line. It is devoted to second hand items and bargains, with new and second hand, ancient and rare books, magazines, catalogues, further to numerous curiosities; many titles are in single copy.
