In the previous catalogue I had anticipated that there would be a surprise regarding a project we were working on... and in fact in September we went on-line with the new website (indeed 2) - vaccari.it and vaccarinews.it - both completely renewed.

Navigation has been made more modern and above all usable from any device: now from mobile, notebook or computer it is easy, fast and more intuitive, without completely upsetting the functionality. The timing of Covid somewhat affected the implementation and pushed the deadline away, but in the end we did it.







The part dedicated to books is even simpler, full of many titles (many more than those in the paper version) with detailed sheets, in-depth descriptions, indexes, notes on the author and all the new works coming out, in real time ready to be ordered.

And we are at thirty-nine!

The paper catalogue "Libreria Filatelica" is renewed with over 50 titles published during the year and the most recent ones.

Some volumes are out of stock and therefore can no longer be found, some are discounted (for example, it is worth taking a look at "vetrina delle occasioni", a bargain window), and then there are the usual GIFTS that reward based on purchases.

On the site there is also the section dedicated to the "1x1" sale, with second-hand and other bargains.

Some books and catalogues we have for sale are imported directly from countries outside the European community: with the new customs rules, for example from Great Britain, delivery times are always a surprise! Not to mention the general disorganization with regard to customs duties and editorial VAT. In short, a situation that we hope will improve soon.

"Vaccari Magazine" is confirmed once again this year as one of the best magazines specialized in philately and postal history and we are very proud of it.

The cover price has undergone a small increase but the subscription price remains frozen as always at 35 euros for Italy (to foreign countries with shipping costs).

The new issue 66 is out by the end of November and is sent to all subscribers in the absence of being able to meet at Veronafil.

We hope we can see each other again at the usual trade fairs next year, to share the passion for this fantastic hobby.

In the meantime, I invite you to leaf through these 48 pages of philatelic culture; there is certainly something interesting.
