Vaccari public and live auction of philately, postal history and literature took place in Vignola (Mo-Italy) on Saturday 11 June 2022, by the auction room of Vaccari srl, via M.Buonarroti 46.

Auctioneer Gabriele Sintoni. Mail bids were dealt with by Paolo Vaccari, who welcomed bidders with a few words:

"Welcome to all at Vaccari auction no.100. We thank you for participating.

The first Vaccari sale was held on 26 April 1977 without an audience. There were 318 lots in all. The written orders arrived in fair quantities and there were only two, really unexpected, phone calls: Giulio Bolaffi and Renato Mondolfo, both to buy more lots. For me and for my dear wife Renata it was a great satisfaction also because, on the next day, Enzo Diena phoned to ask how it had been...

Since then we have reached auction 100, with all the necessary modernities!

The novelty of this year: we have two live connections, one from the Philasearch portal and one from the Bid Inside portal, an important Italian auction platform.

I remind you that the traditional "Renata" buffet will be served during the break. We wanted to continue this tradition also in memory of my wife.

We wish you all great business and fun."


