## **FOREWORD**

An opportunity to meet and spend some time together on Saturday 18 May on the occasion of the next auction which will be **public** and therefore auctioned in the room starting from 10 a.m. There will also be the possibility to connect and participate live on the same day or to send your bids by correspondence on the days preceding up to Friday 17th at 5 p.m.

In the period before the auction, starting already **from Friday 26 April**, I suggest you come and visit us at our offices to **view** the available material in person (by appointment).

Of the 1,438 lots, including philately, postal history and literature, presented in this catalogue no.103, 200 belong to the "Lots and collections" section in which there are many interesting sets, with more or less advanced and more or less complete collections, which deserve careful consideration and require some time and... they guarantee fun.

Among them, some lots stand out: a beautiful collection of Italian Colonies which goes from 1912 to 1942 and is really advanced and with the major rarities of the period; an almost complete one on the IV issue of Sardinia; one specialized in the study of the plates of the black p.1 "Penny Black", the red p.1 and the blue p.2, with descriptions in English in the collector's pen; a collection of mail from 1851 to 1874 between the Kingdom of Sardinia / Kingdom of Italy and Switzerland. Some lots focus on specific themes and are difficult to repeat.

Particular selections are also found in other sections. For example, in the Ancient Italian States one can admire important cancellations of Naples and the Naples Provinces or of Modena. Then there is the first part of a collection, divided into several lots, of Military Mail focused on the First World War which also includes Prisoners of War and correspondence with foreign countries.

In general, the parts dedicated to the Ancient Italian States but also to the Kingdom of Italy are particularly extensive. This time **Literature** offers 162 titles, the result of a choice made within some libraries that we have recently purchased. I have not seen some of the books or catalogues offered for some time. I hope they find the right location.

There are numerous lots that I would like to highlight, but I leave it up to you to browse the catalogue and look for what most attracts you. Anyway, as usual, our daily newspaper **Vaccari news** (www.vaccarinews.it) and our **social** pages will show some of the lots.

There are significantly more images on our site than those included in the paper version (which, in PDF format, can be browsed or downloaded in the dedicated section www.vaccari.it/asta). However, I recommend you come and see them live. We are waiting for you!

#### **DUCHY OF MODENA**

letter with text from Carrara to Philadelphia (USA) of 2.8.1857 franked for L.1,40 with L.1 white n.18 (very good margins) + c.40 dark blue with full stop after the figure n.17 (3 large margins and close at bottom) - Sassone n.10+11 - Carrara 6 bar canc. with handwritten charge "3" alongside, since it was sent "Via di Sarzana" (postmark on the back of 3.8.1857) to Genoa (postmark on the back of 4.8.1857) and then to Philadelphia aboard a French steamer (as a confirmation, the double circle "Sardaigne - Culoz 6 Aout. 57" in red and the ink-pad charge "21", besides the postmark "Paris - Calais 6 Aout. 57" on the back) - uncommon rate for Vito Viti correspondence used with postage to destination "P.D." from 1.5.1857 to 31.10.1858 - this is one of the really few letters from the famous correspondence to be without any crease - splendid and really fresh on the whole - A.Diena - G.Colla (cert.2004) - Paolo Vaccari (cert.2024)

Zocca - Provisional Government c.5 dark green n.23 - Sassone n.12b - partial canc. "Zocca" (repeated) in green azure (p.R3) - good quality - really rare - Em.Diena - A.Diena - En.Diena (cert.1981) - P.V. (photocopy cert.1991)

## **DUCHY OF MODENA - CANCELLATIONS**

Zocca - letter fragment franked with Sardinia c.40 carmine n.55 (close on the right) - Sassone n.16Ca - grid cancellation with boxed "Zocca" alongside, both in green azure (p.R2) - it is a really rare evidence of c.40 cancelled in Zocca with this kind of cancellation: the grid postmark was used, in Modena post office, only from 26.6.1852 to 13.7.1852; it was substituted by another type since it cancelled the postage stamps too lightly; when the post office in Zocca was opened (1.1.1859), besides the nominal postmark and that for registered letters, they received the grid one; in Modena they always used black ink, while in Zocca the few impressions known are in green azure - A.Diena - En.Diena (cert.1990) - Paolo Vaccari (cert.2014)

**Farini Regency**- t.1/2 blue "Crocetta" n.16, unused with original gum with hinge - Sassone  $2024 \, n.16 = \text{euro } 140.000,00 - \text{two sides lightly touched}$  (on the left at top and on the right at bottom) but really fresh - rarity - R.Diena (cert.1993) - P.V. (cert.2024)



#### **NAPLES**

letter sent "Via di Mare" from Naples to Feltre (Veneto) on 14.2.1861 (first day of issue) franked with Naples Provinces gr.5 carmine n.10, with 3 large margins and lightly touched bottom right - Sassone n.21 - boxed "Annullato" with "Partenza da Napoli 14 Feb. 1861" in red alongside - Sassone 2024 = euro 110.000,00+ (the less rare letters) - rarity of the sector - Raffaele Maria Diena (cert.2010: great rarity the 5 grana used on the first day of issue) - Paolo Vaccari (cert.2024)
