FOREWORD

The present catalogue n.98 displays philately and postal history as usual, but also a section devoted to philatelic literature. The 1,146 lots will be on sale at the auction of 5 June. We hope that everything will go in the best way and that we can hold it public by our auction room, obviously respecting all the safety regulations relating to Covid-19 (see the devoted page). Besides people “physically” present, there will be LIVE and telephone connections and bids received in the previous days. Anyway, in case of problems, the auction will be held, even if behind closed doors.

In order to advantage those who wish to remain “distanced”, the lots have **all** been **photographed**, even though some of them only partially just to give an idea of the whole, and all the images are in the catalogue in the site. Moreover, **viewing** of lots will start, **upon appointment**, already on **Monday 10 May**.

Friday 4 June, at 17 (local time), is the deadline for the registration of bids by mail and requests for a telephone connection (via mail, fax, e-mail or internet), and to register to take part Live. Please read our terms of sale, where there is also how to take part in details.

I would like to remind you some points.

- Lots are **described** (some of them also in English in our site) with care and clarity and reproductions are integral part of descriptions.
- At Vaccari auctions, **no commission is applied to buyers' return prices** (generally 20/22%).
- The lots with my initials or signature, regardless of whether they come with or without an expert certificate, are absolutely guaranteed with reference to their description and, **among them, those with a value higher than 500.00 euro come with a Vaccari S.r.l. certificate of guarantee free of charge.**

I will highlight only some of the lots, even though several are important or particular.

Our daily web magazine **Vaccari news** (www.vaccarinews.it) and our **social** pages (facebook, linkedin, twitter, instagram), the institutional one VaccariFilatelia and the on-line VaccariShop, will point out some more. Anyway, I suggest you browse the catalogue or search for what is of interest to you or you like the most.

At the beginning Prephilately and Italian Ancient States, among which the Duchy of Modena and the Kingdom of Naples stand out in particular. For Modena, for example, two pairs of green cent.5 without the full stop after the figure with interpane gutter; or a sheet of 240 exemplars with original gum without hinge of the cent.25 buff with oily impression and gum seepage, which also includes the error “full stop up after CENT” at position 128; one letter from Correggio to Modena of 18.6.1852 franked with the cent.10 bright rose with the full stop after the figure cancelled with Modena red postmark and on the first known date for Correggio; another one, the only registered letter sent from Fanano during the ducal period and the first with postage stamps from that office.

For Naples, the cancellations are particularly relevant (as in the Papal State), but there are also three “Trinacria”, one cancelled, one on newspaper fragment, but also one unused without gum; and then some “Crocette” including one unused without gum; the letters are also many and interesting.



Sicily has great rarities. In all the Ancient States there are also very attractive lots with several examples of covers and postage stamps or fragments at excellent prices, especially in Lombardy Venetia, Sardinia, Tuscany and Kingdom.

I advise you to pay attention also to the section dedicated to “Lots and collections”, ...

I would be tempted to continue to point out other particular items, but all the categories offer lots of a certain interest; I therefore leave it to you to discover them.

In the Air Mail category (edited by Silvia Vaccari) there are two sectors of greatest evidence: a Special dedicated to Italo Balbo, which starts from some examples of the first Italy-Brazil Transatlantic Cruise in 1930 and passes with great emphasis to the second transatlantic flight made in formation of a flock, the North Atlantic Cruise of the Decennial of 1933. A real triumph of the “Atlanteans” on cover and almost all in the two values of L.25 and L.50, classic but also unusual laps, also official covers of the Cruise and with important autographs, some foreign laps up to rarities, including a unique find for Montreal escaped in the historic General Loading List, all characterized by an absolute degree of freshness of the specimens. The section then continues with Different flights, from the most classic to some finds, fifteen Zeppelin on cover, for Rocket mail the complete Barbero one, a preview of the other great sector. Space: some USA lots dedicated to the 40th anniversary of the Shuttles, the USSR-Russia section that opens by celebrating the 60th anniversary of the first man in Space, Yuri Gagarin, and then historically continues with Space Stations commemorative and flown covers, Salyut-3, Salyut-6, Salyut-7, Mir, to then arrive in the section of the ISS, from its origins with a specimen of great rarity, then reviewing the history of the missions of the International Space Station, with a lot of space letters with private mail Earth-Space/Space-Earth up to the most recent specimens of 2019 and 2020 also including the postal testimonies of the private industry of the future, SpaceX.

I would just add that the section dedicated to Literature has also been included in this auction, with some hard-to-find texts, including the 10-year collection of “Filatelia 1962-1972” and the 27-year collection of “Vaccari Magazine”, 1989 -2015, with the 14 issues sold out for some time.
