The yearly catalogue no.24 has the same graphical layout and general organization chosen for last edition, since many positive opinions have been expressed.

Particularly appreciated is the use of different colours for the 13 categories and the several sub-categories into which the **650 titles** have been divided. Among them **73 new books** and the new editions of catalogues, Italian and foreign works about philately and postal history, postage stamps and collecting, history and other subjects connected to the main theme.

In the section "novità Vaccari"

- **5 new publications** of the "Made in Vaccari", the books published by our publishing house. Among them the **new thematic series** started with the volume devoted to the travels completed by Pope John Paul II outside Italy, to commemorate a person who was really important to people all over the world. In the same series, there is now a new work devoted to Football World Championships from 1930 to 2006. The two books have in common, besides their graphical layout, the presentation of each travel/championship from a historical-journalistic point of view, and the reproduction and description of stamps and souvenir sheets issued by the different countries connected to the event.

In "1x1 one by one"

- **more than 1500 titles** about Italian and foreign philately, postal history, military post - new and second hand, ancient and rare books, magazines, catalogues, decrees, postal regulations, and several curiosities

In the section "omaggi"

- **61 titles** divided into three classes based on purchases effected

In "il Formichiere blu"

- a taste of the 20 titles about art, gastronomy, sport, dialect, fiction, local history, folklore, hobbies

The printed version of the Philatelic Bookshop is updated once a year.

Through the **search system** by category, title, author or key word, it is really easy to find a specific book or all the books published about a peculiar subject.
