FOREWORD

30 years have passed from the first sale by offer and it is still, and more and more, with pleasure that we propose interesting philatelic and postal-historical material to the public.

We are really proud of the goals we have attained, even though any target reached represents a starting point for us.

Passion for philately is at the basis of our activity and a goad for the future.

The present catalogue no.72 presents 1462 lots (206 for literature with rarities, out of print books, bargains) accurately described and partly reproduced in colour. In the site www.vaccari.it you can find the reproduction of the 80% of lots and the descriptions also in English.

Among the several proposals, the lots reproduced on cover are particularly important: one cover of Lombardy Venetia (lot 145) franked with c.15 laid paper, extraordinary copy and the only one with cancellation of Milan; one cover of the Grand Duchy of Tuscany (lot 340), extraordinary as to franking and cancellations; one space letter "Apollo 14" (lot 710) with c.10 and postmark "Houston" of 26.2.1971.

In addition to some considerable documents of the Italian States, for example the acknowledgement of receipt of the Duchy of Modena (lot 245) or the cover of the Papal State (lot 286), among the rarest lots to note the really very fine cover (lot 837) sea/lake route from Riva to Peschiera of 30.1.1867 with cancellation "Piros.fo Sermione".

In the section "lots and collections", the 175 offers include several boxes with thousands of letters, mainly Italian ones, belonging to different periods. And in "miscellaneous and curiosities" many autographs, posters (one with the photograph of the Duce), fiscals,...
