As is often mentioned in the preface of the various editions of the Vaccari Catalogue, quotations and trends listed in the catalogue have always been based on the market, thanks to an analysis of realized prices at auctions, direct private sales and commercial retail lists.

From October 2007, when the XIII edition of the bi-yearly Vaccari Catalogue was published, to its expiration in October 2009, we have not seen great changes in the trends already expressed. However, we have noticed a strong interest from new collectors who have stopped traditional European collections, in general, to turn to Italian philately in its many aspects.

This is certainly a good indicator for the future, but it is not enough to justify the new edition with revisions of prices and trends.



Besides the Italian States, it includes all the Provisional Governments and the Kingdom of Italy from 17 March 1861 to 1900, that is to the issues of King Umberto I.

More and more updates even thanks to the co-operation of more than 80 scholars who, with their suggestions and indications, have contributed in improving the present catalogue, at its **XIII edition**.

**96 pages more with respect to last edition.** The additions are relevant to every chapter, but above all to the Kingdom of Naples, the Papal State from 20 September 1870, the Kingdom of Sardinia and the Grand Duchy of Tuscany. Moreover, nearly every reproduction has been changed, many have never been published before; they all show, through their franking, what stated in the part of rates, both inland and for mail addressed to other pre-unity states.

Notwithstanding the hard job needed to present deep historical and postal-historical researches, and to keep the level of contents high, the retail price is extremely low. This choice depends on the fact that the catalogue aims at spreading the postal-historical culture, and it is made possible even thanks to the precious contribution of advertisers, who have shown that they believe in the "philosophy" underlying this catalogue/treatise.
