Twenty years have passed since 30 June 1989, when Silvia and Valeria Vaccari started Edizioni Vaccari s.a.s publishing house with the aim of making philatelic literature available through the publication and distribution of specialized books and catalogues. Edizioni Vaccari then merged with Paolo Vaccari's philately business in Vaccari s.r.l., in 1998.

September 2008 saw the expansion of the book collection and the **creation of the "History Bookshop"**, a catalogue offering a wide range of over 400 titles that cover two centuries of history and military history.

Moments of history: great conflicts, conquests and defeats, expectations and hopes, diaries, treatises, historical documents and images. They are pages of life and war experience, passion and courage which are bravely and spontaneously told by the characters.

The **September 2009** edition of the "**History Bookshop**" no.2 doubles its previous year's titles with over 850 books and a survey of 85 publishers. Among them, are some great Italian publishers such as Il Mulino, Mursia, Laterza and Olimpia, with their history and military history series, as well as publishers specialized in the historical sector, such as Ermanno Albertelli, Giorgio Apostolo, Del Bianco, Gaspari, Itinera Progetti, Lo Scarabeo, Nordpress and Rossato, and others whose works complete the historical eras covered.



An important part of the catalogue is undoubtedly the three sections of the **Italian Army General Staff**: the historical offices of the Army General Staff, which was already included last year, and the new sections of the Air Force and the Navy. They feature over 120 titles which are an ideal source of reference on corps, weapons, transport and uniforms, and act as a unique witness to the experiences of Italian soldiers in Italian history.

The Nineteenth Century category, which offers an overview of the Old Italian States, the Reign of Napoleon, the Risorgimento and Garibaldi, along with the Twentieth Century section, present many new titles. In addition to this, the sections on Aviation, Navy, World War One, the Question of Trieste and the policies regarding Yugoslavia and the Balkans have been tripled.

The "History Bookshop" no.2 has also been expanded considerably in its various **categories and subcategories** of books. Some new categories include: "Fascism", which is examined in all its aspects, from the origins to its development, to World War Two, and even more specialized texts on Mussolini; "People and Nations" with publications on general Italian history, from the Monarchy to the Republic and the history of Jews, which is largely covered in the series on the Shoah of World War Two; in the "History - Traditions - Society" section, the new subcategory, "Secrets and Mysteries", encompasses untold stories of secret services, mysteries, underhand dealings and the horrors and truths of many Italian and foreign mysteries.

"Letters and Correspondences" is the final new addition to the "History Bookshop". This section includes some of the most antique letters in the history of man to even some of the most recent ones, as well as wartime letters, which are also featured in their relative categories, such as the ones on the two World Wars. In this section the "Carteggi" series attests to the complexity of human relationships destined to become profound intellectual understandings and authentic friendships, such as the one between Benedetto Croce and Giovanni Laterza.

Vaccari series "Meeting History" presents the new edition of this year: Mario Cobianchi's volume, "Pionieri dell'Aviazione in Italia 1908-1914", which was published in 1943 and had long been difficult to find. This work offers a sort of encyclopaedia on the pioneering of flight in Italy.

Finally, the "History Bookshop" section, featured on the BOOKS department page of the site, has also been made over: it now allows users to search by publisher, view a complete list of all publishers, and purchase used copies (marked as such) of a small collection of used historical and military history texts. The number of days before shipping is also provided for some volumes.

MEETING HISTORY

For some time the "History through documents" series has continued following a particular guideline: to analyse, through the study of documents and postal history, events or historical topics in an accurate and detailed way thus often revealing details that otherwise would not be easily identifiable.

Within this series, the section "**Meeting History**" has been created, which expands on <u>specific historical topics</u>, with a mostly narrative approach, and is always based on the analysis of documents.

The series has been introduced with Fabio Bonacina's study, "La salma nascosta - Mussolini dopo Piazzale Loreto da Cerro Maggiore a Predappio (1946-1957)", 50 years after Mussolini's body was returned to his family, followed by the volume by Ricciotti Garibaldi, "La camicia rossa nella guerra balcanica campagna in Epiro 1912", on the occasion of the bicentenary of the birth of the author's father, Giuseppe Garibaldi.

The new edition this year is Mario Cobianchi's volume, "Pionieri dell'Aviazione in Italia 1908-1914", which was published in 1943 and had long been difficult to find. This work offers a sort of encyclopaedia on the pioneering of flight in Italy. It has been updated and expanded with numerous notes and an errata at the bottom of the page, edited by Fiorenzo Longhi, one of the greatest experts on Italian aerophilately.
